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2024-25 NFL PLAYOFF PREVIEW

Super Bowl Participants:

The last 16 Super Bowl Participants (Last 8 Super Bowls) and 22 of the last 24, finished the regular season in the top 10 in EPA per drop back. One that didn't were the 2015 Broncos (25th in pass EPA) but they were #1 in pass EPA on defense. The only other team that is an outlier in the last decade was the 2012 Ravens, who finished 15th in pass EPA on offense and 13th on defense.

Potential Fits: BUF, BAL, DET, WAS, TB, PHI, KC, GB

Since 2018, every Super Bowl participant besides one (KC in 2023) has finished top 10 in explosive pass rate (15+ yards) in the regular season:

2023: SF: 1, KC: 20 2022: KC: 2, PHI: 1 2021: CIN: 5, LAR: 2 2020: TB: 4, KC: 5 2019: SF: 1, KC: 9 2018: LAR: 3, NE: 9

Potential Fits: BAL, GB, DET, PHI, PIT, BUF, MIN, LAC

Wildcard Round Playoff Tidbits (just fyi purposes not blanket betting strategies):

- Same season rematches in the playoffs (all rounds) have gone 83-73 (53%) to the over since 2000. 4-0 to the under in the Super Bowl. The over is just 48% when it is an in-division rematch (3rd time) since 2000. In the Wildcard round, indivision rematches have gone over 57% of the time since 2000 by an average of 5.3 ppg. Favorites in these rematches are just 7-13 ATS (35%) in the Wildcard round.
- Among 15 outdoor Wildcard games with a total of 47.5+ since 2000, 13 of those 15 went under the total by an average of 5.1 ppg.
- ·Underdogs have been excellent in the Wildcard round of late. In the last 10 years, dogs are 26-17-1 ATS (61%) and have won 39% of straight up vs an expected win percentage of 31%. Dogs of 7 or less are 20-10 ATS (67%) in the last 10 years with a +3.3 ATS margin. Away dogs of 7 or less are 16-7 ATS (70%) in the last 10 years. Seven straight years an away dog of 7 or less has won outright.
- ·Home dogs in Wildcard games are 14-9-2 ATS (61%) since 2000. Of the 11 Wildcard home underdogs from +1 to +2.5, 10 have covered a six point teaser. 13/14 home dogs in teaser range in any Playoff round since 2000 has covered a six point teaser. In all Playoff rounds, home dogs are 20-12-2 ATS (63%), with 17 outright wins.
- In 21 in-division Wildcard rematches, the underdog is 13-7-1 ATS. 8 of the 13 underdogs won outright.
- · At least one underdog has won outright in this Wildcard round in 15 of past 17 years. Last year three teams (HOU, GB, TB) won outright.
- First-time playoff QB vs non-first time QB are 18-36 SU and 18-35-1 ATS since 2002. Rookie QBs making their first Playoff starts vs a QB not making their Playoff debuts are 5-8 straight up and 7-6 ATS since 2002. If you exclude rookie QBs making their debuts, first time Playoff QBs vs non-first timers are 13-28 SU and 11-29-1 ATS (27%) since 2002.
- · Home favorites over 7 points are 14-7 ATS (67%) (+3.2 ATS margin) in the Wildcard Round since 2000. Home favs of 10+ are 9-1 ATS (+4.3 ATS margin), 10-0 SU.






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REVIEW & ANALYSIS

- •KC had a historically odd regular season. They won 15 games but come into the Playoffs with just the 5th highest point differential in the AFC and 11th among 14 Playoff teams. They have covered just 41% of games this season and according to my blended 4th quarter win share numbers, played like a team that should have won only 11.5 games, by far the biggest overachieving team in the NFL. Only the 2003 New England Patriots, was a bigger overachiever in the regular season than these Chiefs and won a SB.
- •The Chiefs offense ranks just 31st in explosive play rate but rank 4th (excludes week 18 with backups) best in success rate and are top seven in both passing and rushing. Patrick Mahomes ranks 2nd in success rate and 4th in EPA on 3rd and 4th downs.
- Mahomes' best and 3rd best EPA games of the entire season came in his final two starts vs HOU and PIT, both of whom rank inside the top 10 in pass defense. Maybe its coincidence but that coincides with Hollywood Brown entering the lineup. Could it be a sign of things to come for this offense?
- •The KC defense finished top 10 in success rate against both the run and pass. The pass defense struggled from weeks 8-14, coinciding with the loss of CB Jaylen Watson (29th in EPA in that stretch) but picked back up in their final three games (with the starters), ranking 2nd in EPA allowed. Watson is expected to return for the Playoffs.





REVIEW & ANALYSIS

- They have benefitted the most from EPA gained on net TOs in the league. They have lost the 2nd least amount of EPA from turnovers on offense and have gained the 2nd most on defense. Only fumbling 9 times on offense (lowest in NFL) and created 26 fumbles on defense (most in NFL). They committed just one turnover in the 2nd half of games where the margin was within one score, lowest in the league.
- Excluding turnovers, the defense ranks 28^{th} out 32 teams in EPA allowed. Including TOs, on 3^{rd} and 4^{th} downs, Buffalo's defense ranks 29^{th} in EPA. The Bills defense has faced the 9^{th} easiest schedule of opposing offenses, easiest schedule of opposing rush offenses by EPA.
- •Buffalo's offense has been elite all season, ranking #2 in EPA, top three in both rushing and on drop backs. Bills offense had a league leading 76% of games where their offense has exceeded their team total at +5.9 ppg. 11 of 17 Bills games went over the total in the first half of games as well.
- Josh Allen ranks #1 in EPA and in PFFs big time throw rate. Along with Lamar Jackson, he and Allen are the only Playoff QBs that rank top 4 in EPA vs both man and zone coverages this year



REVIEW & ANALYSIS

- The Ravens rank #1 in the NFL in explosive play rate on offense (13%) and #1 on defense with the least amount allowed (7%).
- The Ravens also rank #1 in offensive yards per play at over 7.0. The gap between Baltimore and #2 is the same as the #2 and #12 ranked teams.
- A league leading 76% of Ravens games have gone over the over/under total by an average of nearly 5 points per game.
- ·Based on opponent aggregate EPA, they have faced the single toughest schedule of opposing defenses.
- •The Baltimore defense struggled to start the season (weeks 1-8) ranking just 26th in EPA, 28th vs the pass. From week 9 on, the Ravens are the NFLs #2 ranked EPA defense, #1 in success rate. Their pass defense ranks 2nd in the NFL in that stretch.







REVIEW & ANALYSIS

- ·CJ Stroud and this passing offense has severely regressed in 2024. Even though he has faced the $3^{\rm rd}$ easiest schedule of opposing pass defenses, he ranks just $30^{\rm th}$ in EPA and $34^{\rm th}$ in success rate. Stroud has been pressured at the $4^{\rm th}$ highest rate in the league.
- Stroud is still elite on intermediate throws (10–19 yards), ranking 5th best in the league in EPA. However, he has struggled badly on deep throws, ranking 33rd out of 35 QBs.
- Early downs continue to haunt this offense. The Texans rank 31st in offensive success rate and 32nd on the ground on 1st downs this season. On 2nd down its not any better ranking 31st in success rate. Stroud has had to save them on 3rd downs with a top 15 pass success rate and EPA.
- •The Texans defense has been boom or bust. They rank top 10 in both pass and run defense by success rate, with the $2^{\rm nd}$ highest pressure rate and $4^{\rm th}$ most sacks in the league. However, they have also allowed a 10% explosive play rate which ranks $20^{\rm th}$ in the NFL. Opponents have a 9.0 ADOT against Houston, third highest in the NFL. They have missed the $6^{\rm th}$ most tackles in the league. They have dominated against slot WRs, allowing the lowest EPA per target in the NFL.
- · Houston's 44% ATS cover rate ranks 2nd lowest among all Playoff teams outside of the Chiefs.








- •The Chargers are just above an average team based on opponent adjusted success rate and EPA metrics. They did exceed market expectations, easily clearing their win total and covering the spread at the highest rate in the NFL, at 76%. However, they finished just 2-5 straight up, 4-3 ATS vs Playoff teams.
- They finished 5th in defensive EPA, 5th vs the pass and 9th vs the run. However, based on EPA they faced the 5th easiest schedule of opposing QBs. They were fortunate to face backups in Aiden O'Connell, Spencer Rattler, Jameis Winston, Kirk Cousins, Justin Fields to go with guys like Gardner Minshew, Will Levis and Bryce Young early in the season prior to his turnaround.
- The Chargers ranked 9th in rush EPA allowed but finished 27th in opponent adjusted ypc allowed to RBs. They finished 30th, last among Playoff teams, in yards allowed after contact.
- The defense was great, even though they faced an easy schedule. They allowed the lowest rate of opponent drives to reach the red zone, allowed the lowest TD percentage in the league (45%) when opponents did reach the red zone and finished #1 in the NFL in lowest 3rd down conversions vs expected.
- ·Herbert ended 2024 11th in EPA per drop back, 19th in success rate but 4th in PFF grade. He threw 23 TDs with only 3 INTs. His final three games were particularly impressive, as he led the NFL in EPA by a mile and success rate at 64%. His only reliable weapon was rookie WR Ladd McConkey, who finished 11th in the league in EPA per target and 9th in yards allowed per route run.





- The Steelers are on a four-game losing streak heading into the Playoffs, tied with the 99 Lions and 86 Jets as the only team with a 4+ game streak. The Lions lost in the Wildcard round while the Jets won. Four other teams since 2000 (01 Raiders, 11 Texans, 11 Broncos and 16 Lions) rode a three game losing streak into the Playoffs. Those teams went 3-1 SU and ATS in their Wildcard games.
- · As usual, the Steelers defense has feasted off turnovers. They rank #1 in the NFL in EPA generated off turnovers in the 2nd half of one score games. They have needed those TOs bc the defense ranks just 20th in success rate allowed. They have also allowed the 2nd highest rate of throws over the middle of the field.
- The vaunted Steelers pass rush finished league average in the NFL in pressure rate.
- •Russell Wilson has solely relied on the deep ball. He ranks #2 in the NFL in EPA on 20+ air yard throws but bottom five on throws under 10 yards.
- •Only 10 of their last 42 offensive drives (L4 games) have reached the red zone. From a season long perspective, that would rank 3rd worst in the NFL. In this four game losing streak, the offense ranks 31st in EPA.






- The Broncos defense has been elite, ranking #1 in EPA. However, they have faced the 5th easiest schedule of opposing pass offenses. Lamar Jackson, Joe Burrow and Justin Herbert all generated an EPA per drop back of at least +0.350 and a success rate of 63% in games vs DEN. Those all ranked as a top four game in terms of EPA and success rate for each of those QBs this season.
- •They ranked 3rd in lowest points per game allowed but they also allowed 53% of opposing offenses to go over their team totals. They are the only defense in the top eight in PPG allowed to also allow opposing offenses to go over their team total in 50%+ of games.
- After starting the season with four negative EPA games in his first five starts, Bo Nix finished the season with 10 positive EPA games in his final 12. Nix ranks 12th in the NFL in EPA during that span. Nix has done a great job avoiding sacks with the 8th lowest pressure to sack ratio in the league.
- Marvin Mims has been a revelation late in the season and could be a major wildcard vs Buffalo. He ranks 9th in the NFL among WRs in yac over expected, 24th in EPA per target and #1 in the league in average separation. He has 216 receiving yards on 16 receptions and 4 TDs in the last three games alone.
- Denver ranks third in the NFL in ATS cover percentage at 71%, by 6.7 ppg, 2nd best in the league.




- Tied with the Chargers with a 75% ATS win percentage. An incredible feat considering they have now covered 70% of their regular season games in the last four years under Dan Campbell.
- •The Lions offense continues to dominate and rank 3rd in EPA on drop backs and 5th on runs. They also rank 5th in explosive play rate on offense. Jahmyr Gibbs ranks #2 among NFL RBs in rush EPA behind Derrick Henry. He ran for 109+ yards in each of the final three games. David Montgomery has a shot to come back for the Playoffs and could eat a bit into Gibbs' usage.
- The offense is even more impressive considering they faced the 3rd toughest schedule of opposing defenses. They also rank 20th in the NFL and last among Playoff teams in EPA lost due to turnovers in 2nd half of one score games. Defensively, they rank just 26th with only two close game turnovers. Any sort of late game TO regression is only a positive for the Playoffs.
- The Detroit def. has been decimated by injuries which has been well documented. No team runs more man coverage than the Lions at 45%. QBs in the NFC like Sam Darnold, Jordan Love and Jalen Hurts have much higher EPAs vs man than zone.
- The defense ranks 7th in EPA on the season but since week 13, when all of the injuries started to pile up, they sit just 28th. To be fair, between MIN, GB, SF and BUF they faced four of the better offenses in the NFL.
- There were 35 games with 60+ points and the Lions were in in six alone.



- · After a slow start the Eagles defense was elite, ranking #1 in success rate and #3 in EPA allowed on the season. The Eagles pass defense ranked #1 in pass success rate allowed and #1 in lowest ypa allowed led by rookie CBs Cooper Dejean and Quinyon Mitchell. Both rank top 20 by PFF in coverage grade. The pass defense ranks #2 in lowest EPA allowed on 20+ air yard throws.
- The Eagles offense ranks top 10 in both rushing and drop back EPA. They also rank 6th in explosive play rate and #2 in highest percent of drives that end inside the red zone. They have faced the single easiest schedule of opposing defenses by EPA.


- Tampa's offense ranks 3rd in explosive plays on offense and 6th in lowest rate on defense. The offense has faced the single easiest schedule of defenses in the last six weeks.
- Baker Mayfield has been awesome this year (5th in EPA, 6th in PFF grade). However, he has gotten away with some turnover worthy plays. His 16 INTs is tied for most in the NFL and leads the league with 25 turnover worthy plays by PFF. 10 of his 16 INTs (most in the NFL) have come vs man coverage.
- •RB Bucky Irving has had an incredible rookie season. He ranks #2 in the NFL in yards after contact per rush and #5 in rush yards over expected. Among RBs, he has faced the 2nd easiest schedule of opposing run defenses.
- •The Bucs pass defense has struggled all year (19th in EPA per drop back, 27th in success rate) but the run defense has been dominant. Since week 10 they rank #1 in lowest rush EPA allowed and have allowed an opponents bottom three rush EPA game in 6 of the last 8 games.
- Tampa has seen some positive luck in some high leverage categories. They have seen opposing FG kickers make the 2nd lowest FG% in the league (75%) against them, they have the 4th highest red zone TD % on offense, have the lowest red zone failures (missed FG, TO or loss of downs) in the NFL, #1 in offensive 3rd down converted over expected and have recovered the 6th highest rate of their offensive fumbles in the league.




- The Rams offense sputtered down the stretch and generally they played very low scoring games in the first half of games. Only five of their 17 games went over the 1H total. If you exclude week 18 with Jimmy G at QB, the Rams scored one first half TD in the final three games with Matthew Stafford. They rank just 20th in EPA in those final three games.
- •Stafford has wide splits when facing zone vs man coverages. He ranks 9th in success rate vs zone and 32nd against man coverage, the largest gap of any QB in the Playoffs. He has also struggled vs pressure this season, ranking 30th in EPA per drop back. He is 10th best vs the blitz, however, and has the 5th lowest time to throw when facing a blitz.
- The Rams rank just 23rd in explosive plays on offense, 31st on the ground.
- •The Rams defense has struggled and have allowed the 6th highest rate of opponent drives to reach the red zone. They rank 10th in pressures on defense but has struggled defending the pass. They sit 28th in EPA vs drop backs, by far worst among playoff teams and rank 29th in explosive pass plays allowed.
- •On an opponent adjusted basis, the Rams have allowed the highest target share to TEs this season. They have allowed the highest EPA per target to outside WRs and 3rd lowest to slot WRs.
- ·Based on blended 4th quarter win share, the Rams have overachieved at the 4th highest rate this season.






- The Vikings are 9-2 in one score games, only 2nd to the Chiefs in close games. However, they held an 80%+ win probability in the 4th quarter of five of those wins and opponents scored late often to turn the final into a one score outcome.
- · Minnesota ranks 5th in explosive pass rate and Sam Darnold has needed to hold onto the ball to execute those deep throws. His 3.08 time to throw ranks 3rd most in the NFL. Bc of that he has allowed the 3rd highest rate of pressures in the league.
- · No defense blitzed more this season (40.6%) than Brian Flores and the Vikings. However, they only ranked 13th in pressures and 22nd in sacks on those blitzes. It's a feast or famine strategy as they have allowed the highest average separation from receivers and most yac over expected when they blitzed this season. They generated 13 turnovers in the 2nd half of close games, most in the NFL. No defense has held opposing offenses to a bottom 20th percentile performance more than the Vikings.
- For the first 12 weeks, the Vikings have allowed the 5th lowest explosive pass rate. But since week 13, Minnesota has allowed an 11% explosive play rate, which ranks 5th most in the league.






- Jayden Daniels has been awesome this year and his +0.202 EPA per dropback ranks 6th in the NFL. That also ranks as the 5th best rookie season of any QB since 2010.
- · Washington's offense reached the red zone nearly 42% of drives, the highest rate in the NFL. However, since week 10, the offense has reached the red zone on just 33% of drives. Since week 10, Washington ranks 15th in EPA and 10th in success rate on offense. In the last six weeks, no offense has produced a lower explosive pass rate than Washington.
- •The Commanders defense ranks 22nd in EPA for the season but has been susceptible to big plays of late allowing the 2nd highest rate of explosive plays in the last six weeks of the season. When adjusting for schedule, the Commanders defense has only held 24% of opposing offenses to an EPA below expectations, the 4th worst mark in the league. Against the five top 10 EPA offenses they faced this year (BAL, PHI 2x, TB, CIN), Washington did not hold a single offense below their seasonal average.
- The Commanders run defense struggled the most on outside runs, allowing the highest ypc to RBs this season. They allowed 2.65 yards prior to contact on runs outside the tackles, most in the league.



- •If we exclude the weird week 18 game vs the Bears when Love got hurt, every one of the Packers 5 losses came against the top three teams in the NFC- PHI, DET 2x, MIN 2x. They only lost one of those games (v DET) by more than five points.
- Jordan Love finished just 15th in success rate but #1 in explosive pass rate. Love was graded by PFF as the league's 16th best QB and was only credited with the 26th highest rate of big time throws. Losing Christian Watson is a big blow as he has been Love's top target on throws 20+ yards in the air.
- Surprisingly, the Packers have turned into a very run heavy offense and have focused on Josh Jacobs. No team has run the ball (51%) more in neutral game situations than the Packers this season. Even if you exclude games with Malik Willis, it is still the most run heavy team in the league. Will GB allow Love to win them games in the Playoffs?
- •The Packers defense has benefitted greatly from turnovers, ranking 5th in EPA generated. No team in the NFL has anywhere near the gap between success rate defending the pass (28th) and EPA (3rd) like the Packers. Excluding turnovers, they rank 31st in success rate in pass defense. They do cover the deep ball well and rank #1 in the NFL in lowest EPA allowed on 20+ air yard throws.
