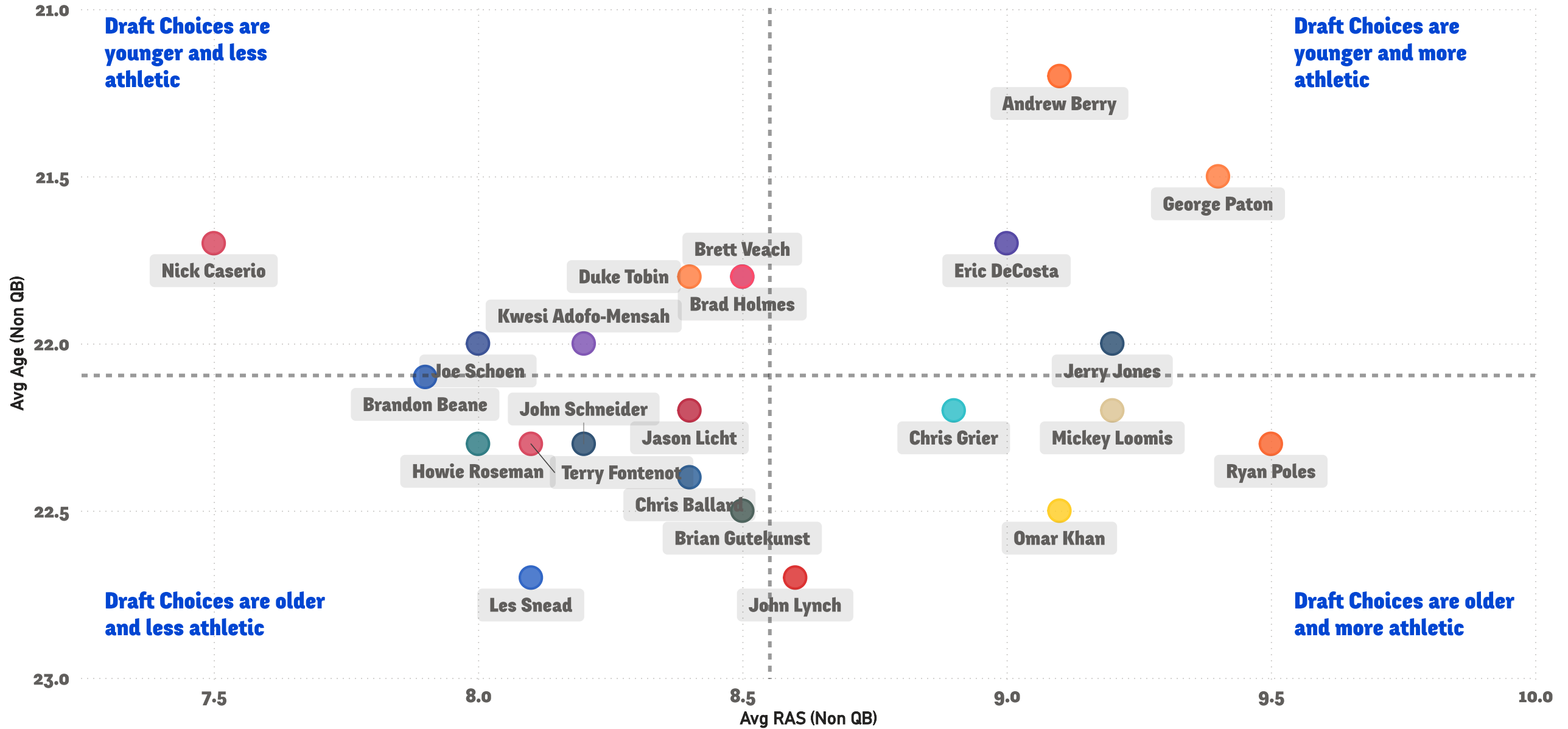

ANDREW BERRY

GM PROFILE

Andrew Berry has leaned into drafting younger players than every other NFL GM. This is especially true early in drafts.

• He has only made five top two round selections with CLE, but he is the only current GM not to draft any player in the top two rounds over the age of 22 and he has yet to draft one over 21.6 yo at the time of the draft.

• 57% of all his draft picks have been on players under 22 yo, also highest among GMs.

• Among his top two round picks, Berry has not drafted a player with an available RAS under 8.4.

• However, 7 of his 32 other selections with an available RAS from round 3 on, had a RAS under 5.0. The further down the draft, he and the Browns rely much less on measured athleticism.

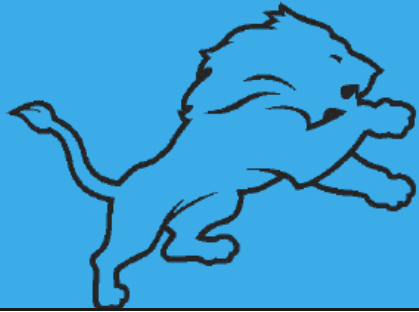

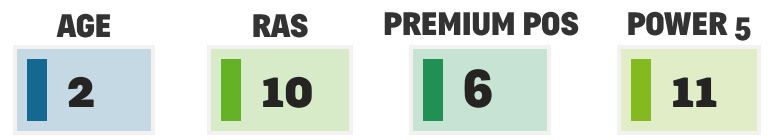
BRAD HOLMES

GM PROFILE

No GM has drafted a higher rate of Pro Bowl players since 2019 than Holmes (21%).

- Holmes tilts toward younger players generally. His 22.3 average age of player drafted and 46% under the age of 22 yo, rank 2nd in the NFL behind Andrew Berry
- 5 of his 6 first round selections have been players under the age 21.8 years old including Aiden Hutchinson, Penei Sewell and Jahmyr Gibbs.
- In fact, Sewell, Gibbs, Terrion Arnold and Jameson Williams are four of the 20 youngest first round picks since 2020.
- Holmes also loves drafting big school players higher in the draft. 18/20 selections made in the top four rounds for Holmes have been from Power 5 schools and you can argue that the two non Power 5 players (Brodrick Martin from WKY and Giovanni Manu from British Columbia) have been his two worst so far.

BRANDON BEANE

GM PROFILE

Beane is one of the longest tenured GMs currently still active and has clearly built excellent rosters throughout.

• Beane has generally been a bit contrarian when it comes to athleticism (RAS), with his draftees ranking as the 2nd least athletic among GMs in the NFL in the last five years. He has taken guys like AJ Epenesa (4.06 RAS), Devin Singletary (1.65) and Zack Moss (2.81) in the top three rounds of the draft. Interestingly, the last few drafts we have seen him shy away from that a bit high in the draft but it was really pronounced from 2018-2020.

• Beane has gone 11/11 in drafting Power 5 players in the top two rounds of the draft since 2019, however from rounds 3+, his 69% rate ranks third lowest among GMs. He has hit on later round non Power 5 players like Khalil Shakir (5th round) and Christian Benford (6th round).

• Among GMs in the last two drafts, Beane's draftees have an average age of 23 years old, 3rd highest in the NFL. Last season, 38 players were drafted age 24 or older and Beane took three of them (Ray Davis, Edefuan Ulofoshio, Tylan Grabble).

BRETT VEACH

GM PROFILE

Beach has been one of the best GMs in the NFL the last handful of seasons, helping to lead the Chiefs to three straight Super Bowl appearances.

• There is nothing as certain as a Chiefs 1st round selection being on a very young player under Veach. He has made five 1st round picks in his career and each player was drafted at age 21 at the time of the draft. 21.6 is the max (Trent McDuffie) age of his 1st round picks. McDuffie, Karlaftis and last year's top pick, Xavier Worthy, all look to be big hits.

• Veach has been one of if not the best GMs in recent drafts at finding really quality interior OL. He has hit on guys like C Creed Humphrey and G Trey Smith, both in the 2021 draft.

• Only 74% of Veach's picks since 2019 have been on a player from a Power 5 school, 2nd lowest among GMs. He has nailed some recently on guys like Rashee Rice, L'Jarius Sneed and Josh Williams. All three of those players also scored very highly in athletic testing with a 9.3 RAS or higher.

BRIAN GUTEKUNST

GM PROFILE

Gutekunst has been GM of the Packers since 2018 and has one of the more interesting profiles of any NFL GM.

• Gutekunst has tilted toward very good athletes in round one as all seven picks in his GM career have generated a RAS of 8.4 or higher. Five straight and six of the last seven 1st round picks had a RAS of >9.0 including Jordan Morgan (9.2) last year.

• If you extend out into the 2nd round as well, all but two of the 17 players he has selected, scored at least an 8.0 RAS. One player (Josh Myers) did not test.

• No GM has drafted more players outside of the Power 5 than Gutekunst (56%). His skill selections from non Power 5 schools have been excellent overall- Jordan Love, Christian Watson, Tucker Kraft, Romeo Doubs and MVS.

CHRIS BALLARD

GM PROFILE

Ballard has consistently been lauded as a respected GM but recently his drafts have been some of the biggest underachieving in the NFL.

• Ballard is polar opposite when it comes to athleticism and age in the draft. His 52 non QB selections have resulted in an incredible average RAS of 8.9, highest among any GM with at least three drafts under their belts. 58% of all his drafted players have posted a 9.0+ RAS, highest mark as well. All six his last 1st and 2nd round picks who tested, posted at least a 9.3 RAS.

• There have been nine total players who have generated a 9.99-10.0 RAS score in the last three drafts and Ballard has drafted four of those players- Anthony Richardson, Juju Brents, Adonai Mitchell and Jelani Woods.

• Among 37 Ballard non-QB selections in the last five drafts, who posted a RAS score, only draftee (2024 6th round pick Micah Abraham) posted a RAS below 7.6.

• In addition, since 2019, only Jonathan Taylor has been a top two round draftee of Ballard at a non-premium position.

• As much as Ballard clearly targets great athletes at premium positions early in the draft, he also does not care about age thresholds. He has drafted the 2nd oldest crop of players since 2019, at 22.9 years old. 56% of his picks in that span have been 23 years or older at the time of the draft, 4th highest among active GMs.

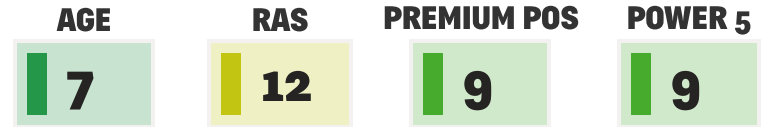

Igbinoghene and Jackson were both under 21 and two of the 15 youngest players in those entire draft classes.

• His last three 1st round picks- Igbinoghene, Jackson and Robinson last year, all generated a RAS of 9.5+ and Waddle who did not workout, was expected to run a blazing 40 if he had worked out.

• Defenders drafted high by Tobin- DJ Turner, Dax Hill and Myles Murphy all look like busts to this point. Cam Taylor-Britt is just ok as a 2nd round pick in 2022. Considering the Bengals best defender, Trey Hendrickson, came via Free Agency, that side of the ball has been a black mark on his draft record.

• Tobin has concentrated a lot on non-premium positions in rounds 2+ especially at Safety and TE. Outside of Jesse Bates, none have been successful.

• Among the 22 top two round selections in his career, Tobin has yet to draft a player outside of a Power 5 school. He has drafted two in round three and both have been at LB-Logan Wilson (Wyoming) and Nick Vigil (Utah St)

Howie is currently renowned as being the best of the best among NFL GMs.

• Howie clearly leans into the pro analytics tendencies, mainly just avoiding pitfalls like drafting poor athletes and/or older players.

• Andre Dillard is the only non-QB player Howie has drafted over age 22.8 in round one since 2013. Considering that failure along with Danny Watkins (26.5) in 2011, it is clear Howie will likely fade older players this high.

• Howie's biggest misses in the 1st round in his career have come from either older players or poor athletes. Four of his five worst 1st round misses have come from the players who tested the worst with a RAS of 7.5 or less (Agholar, Reagor, Marcus Smith and Watkins).

• Since 2019, among his 45 selections, none of his drafted players have generated a RAS of <5.6. He has not drafted a round one or two player with a RAS less than 9.2 in the last four drafts. I do not think this is coincidence considering he whiffed on poor athletes in Reagor and Whiteside in 2019 and 2020, both posting a RAS under 6.2.

Licht has been one of the better drafting GMs over a consistent period of 10 years.

• Licht has interestingly gone from drafting a lot of younger players earlier in his GM career to avoiding young players at one of the highest rates in the league. From 2014-2018, 40% of his drafted players were under 22 yo, however since that time only 19% of non-QBs have been that young, lowest rate in the NFL.

• After hitting big on Triston Wirfs (21.3 yo) and Antoine Winfield Jr. (21.7) in 2020, he has only drafted one player (Graham Barton 21.9 in 2024) under the age of 22 in the 1st two rounds of the draft.

• No GM is more open to drafting non-Power 5 players early in the draft than Licht. 3 of his 12 round 1 & 2 selections since 2019 have been non-Power 5 players, the highest rate in the league. There have only been 16 such players drafted in the top two rounds and Licht accounts for almost 20% of those by himself.

In typical Jerry Jones fashion, he is not only listed as the Owner and President but is the official GM as well for Dallas. Will McClay is VP of Player Personnel and many sight him as the true GM of this team fwiw. But its Jerry's team.

- Whomever is making the final draft decisions for Dallas, the Cowboys have been one of the better drafting teams over the last 5+ seasons. Only Holmes in Detroit has drafted a higher percentage of Pro Bowl players than Jerry and the Cowboys (18%) since 2019. They have really excelled at finding mid-late round gems and not only lead the NFL in most Pro Bowlers drafted from rounds 3 on, but their five selections dwarf everyone else with two as the next highest in this stretch. Guys like CB Daron Bland (5th round) and C Tyler Biadasz (4th round) highlight these late gems.

- Another area where the Cowboys have blown away the competition is finding gems in players drafted outside of the Power 5 schools. They have drafted the 3rd highest rate of those players since 2019 and many have turned into Pro Bowl caliber players like Tyler Smith and Bland. Dating back even further, Dallas has hit on smaller school stars like Demarcus Lawrence, Demarcus Ware and Byron Jones.

- While Jerry and company are near league average when it comes to the general age of drafted players, Dallas has drafted a player under the age of 22 in five straight 1st rounds.

After the embarrassment of the offseason Hard Knocks and subsequent success of Saquon Barkley and the Eagles, Schoen is likely on his last leg this offseason. His drafts have been a mixed bag but he will have to nail the 2025 draft to likely stick around.

Two things stand out for Schoen in his three drafts so far. He does not use the draft to attack the most premium positions and instead 50% of all his picks have gone to non-premium position players, most among NFL GMs. He has drafted a Safety in three straight drafts, an RB in two straight and two TEs in the last three seasons. The Safety and RB position are particularly interesting considering he likely was chasing his losses in FA with Xavier McKinney and Barkley leaving. At least all four of his 1st round picks have been at premium spots.

- He also loves to draft elite athletes in the 1st round. Of the four 1st round picks, who tested (Nabers, Thibodeaux and Banks), all generated a RAS of at least 9.6.

- All 11 of Schoen's top three round picks and 22/24 total draft selections, have come from the Power 5.

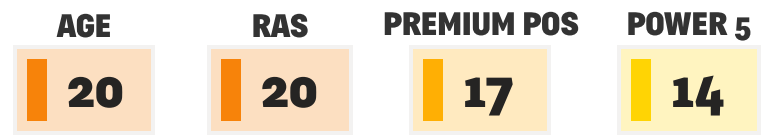
Lynch might be the most antithesis to an analytics focused GM in the NFL, based on his style of drafting. He is one of just five GMs that rank below average in all these three categories- age, athleticism, premium pick %.

- Only 42% of his draftees were either under the age of 22 or posted a RAS of 9+, lowest combined % among NFL GMs. 53% of his non-QB selections since 2019 have been on players age 23 or older.

- Lynch just makes odd decisions. He has drafted a Punter in the 4th round and a Kicker in the 3rd round since 2019. Athleticism has proven to be most correlated with success in drafting TEs yet he has drafted four of them since 2019 and none posted a RAS score >6.9. Its weird considering one of his best draft picks was George Kittle in 2017 after dominating the combine with a 9.52 RAS.

- Lynch has drafted eight WRs since 2019 and all but two were drafted over the age of 23 yo. Only Brandon Aiyuk and Rickey Pearsall posted high RAS scores among them as well.

JOHN SCHNEIDER

GM PROFILE

Generally speaking, John Schneider has profiled as one of the more old school GMs currently in the NFL. He sits below the league GM average when it comes to age, RAS and premium position %.

- Schneider has consistently spent high picks on RBs, using a top 55 pick in back to back seasons on an RB- Kenneth Walker and Zach Charbonnet. A few years prior he spent the 27th pick in the 1st round on Rashaad Penny. All three are clear poor value selections.

- He also used a 1st round pick in 2020 on LB Jordyn Brooks who played a non-premium position and was vastly over drafted. When you compare some of Schneiders picks to consensus boards or use a data point like ESPNs Scouts Inc grades, he has over drafted four different players inside the top 50 picks who were expected to be drafted at least 20 spots lower than where Schneider drafted them- Brooks, Marquise Blair, Derrick Hall and Darrell Taylor. From 2019-2023, there were only 35 such players over drafted by more than 20 spots using this as a barometer and Schneider accounts for four by himself.

- Schneider drafted WR D'wayne Eskridge at 56 overall as an undersized WR from a MAC school, in Western Michigan, at age 24 who posted a poor 6.7 RAS. That is as far away from a data driven selection as you will find that high.

- Since 2016, there have been nine non-QBs players drafted in the top-2 rounds who were old prospects (>23 yo) and posted mediocre/poor athletic workouts (RAS <7.0). Schneider alone has drafted three of those nine (Eskridge, LJ Collier and Jarran Reed).

GM PROFILE

Kwesi is an interesting GM, considering he has a deep analytics background. Unlike the former team he cut his teeth with, the Browns, Kwesi has not exhibited the same affinity for younger, more athletic prospects so far.

- He has only made 20 selections in his short career, but his 22.9 average drafted age ranks as the oldest among active GMs. To be fair, among his five top 50 selections, all were under 23 yo and four of the five under 22 yo. Its what happens after the first round where it gets choppy.
- Only five of his 18 picks after the top 50 selections, have been on players under 23 yo. He has drafted four players aged 24+ in the last two drafts, 2nd most in the NFL.
- Kwesi also is not heavy into athletic testing, as evidenced by his 7th lowest average RAS per draftee. Only 16% of his draftees have put up a RAS of 9+, 2nd lowest among GMs. He also traded up in round one last year for Dallas Turner, which was likely an overpay.

GM PROFILE

One thing is for certain with Les Snead, he and the Rams believe in their own unique system of evaluating players and have shown to be one of the best front offices in the NFL.

• They not only draft generally older players (oldest among top two round picks since 2019), but they also don't attend the Senior Bowl or the Combine and use their own GPS tracking system to evaluate speed and athleticism.

• In the last two drafts, he has nabbed 23 yo Jared Verse, 24 yo Braden Fiske and 23 yo Steve Avilla in the top two rounds. In fact, seven of his 10 draft picks last year were 23 or older. In 2023, he drafted two players over the age of 25! Stetson Bennet (25.5) and Byron Young (25.1) were two of the three oldest players of the entire 2023 draft and Snead took both.

• To Snead's credit, he went young late in the 2023 draft and grabbed one of the best late round values in the last decade in 5th round pick Puka Nacua in 2023 (21.9 yo).

• Snead has shown that he and the Rams can find hidden gems on guys who posted poor standard testing metrics at the combine. For example, Nacua, Taylor Rapp, Jordan Fuller, Kyren Williams and Cobie Durant all posted RAS scores under 6.0 and dropped in the draft due to poor testing. Only Rapp was drafted prior to round 4.

Loomis and the Saints continue the annual tradition of keeping a mediocre roster together held up by shoestrings with a lack of cap flexibility.

• Loomis loves drafting highly athletic players. He has drafted just one non-QB since 2019 with a RAS of less than 7.5 (Khristian Boyd in 2024 at 4.6). Incredibly, 81% of all his selections who worked out prior to the draft, posted a RAS of >8.0.

• Among nine 1st round picks since 2017, the Saints have not drafted a single player with a RAS of less than 8.6. All but Chris Olave generated a 9.0+ RAS in that stretch.

• While Loomis is more of an outlier GM when it comes to athleticism, he also has drafted the highest percentage of players outside of the Power 5 since 2019 (29%). He has drafted 10 such players in this stretch and interestingly, the average age is well over 23 yo. Quite frankly, only 2019 7th round pick Kaden Ellis has become a quality NFL player, including 1st round bust Trevor Penning in 2022. Loomis is likely living off past success with big hits on Terron Armstead (Ark Pine Bluff) and Trey Hendrickson (FL Atlantic), but that has not translated well in recent drafts.

Monti has only led two drafts and 21 picks so far for Arizona so it may be a bit too soon to make any judgements.

• While still on a smaller sample, Ossenfort has drafted the highest rate of players at premium positions (81%) and 2nd highest Power 5 players (95%) since 2019. He has only drafted three players at non premium positions and none prior to round three among his five top two round picks.

• Monti has drafted just one player outside of a Power 5 school among his 21 selections and it was WR Tejhaun Palmer in the 6th round from UAB.

• Ossenfort has leaned into more athleticism so far as well and has not drafted a single player with a RAS <7.2 in the first 150 picks.

• Five of his six highest selections so far have been on players aged 22 yo or younger. Only Darius Robinson (22.6 yo) was over 22 among his higher selections so far. Monti does lean much older as the draft goes along as he has drafted six players from round 3 on who started the NFL season age 24 or older.

NICK CASERIO

GM PROFILE

I am not sure any GM that is currently active has as interesting of a profile as Caserio. He is an outlier in all four main categories and ranks either top or bottom five in all four metrics.

• First and foremost, Caserio has made 32 draft selections in his short GM career and 100% of those picks have gone to players at Power 5 schools. He is the only GM who can say that. And these are best of the best blue blood teams as Alabama, OSU, Michigan, Notre Dame and LSU account for nearly 40% of all his selections to date.

• Caserio has also leaned into younger players (4th youngest among GMs), the least athletic players (last among GMs) and players are non-premium positions (2nd highest among GMs).

• Caserio has drafted a LB in every one of his drafts as well as three TEs and two RBs. He has also invested heavily in the interior of the OL with three G/C. These are all positions that have proven to be most cost effective and bargains in FA and not the draft which should be dedicated more to positions with high surplus value.

• The lack of athletic traits in his selections is fascinating. In the last two drafts, Caserio has not selected a single player with a RAS over 8.5 and only two players over 8.0. He is the only GM to accomplish this and only one other GM has drafted less than three players with a RAS of 8+ in the last two drafts. Tank Dell and Kamari Lassiter have been good success stories among players who underwhelmed in workouts but otherwise the rest of the players with poor metrics in those drafts have struggled for Houston.

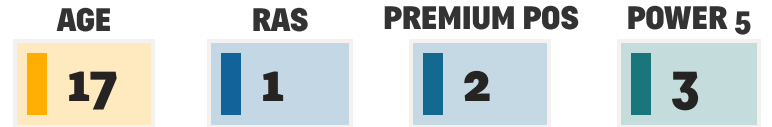
GM PROFILE

Khan has only made 14 selections in two drafts and ranks as the lowest sample among GMs in this analysis so take most of this with a grain of salt.

- So far Khan has shown to love athleticism, drafting premium positions and guys from big schools.
- Khan's draftees have averaged a 9.1 RAS, highest among GMs. An incredible 71% of his 14 selections were on players with a RAS of 9+. He has yet to select a player who did not register a RAS score, and none have generated a score of less than 7.4. He has isolated the best athletes with his late picks so far as all four of his 6th and 7th round picks have been on guys with a RAS of 9.1+.

- Mason McCormick (SD St) is the only player drafted from a non-power 5 school so far for Khan

GM PROFILE

The jury is still out if Poles knows what he is doing as a GM. He has made some head scratching moves while also making a great trade with Carolina to trade back in the 2023 draft while nabbing DJ Moore and setting the stage for holding the #1 pick last year. He has tried to build up the OL and Secondary first and foremost in his three drafts but so far the results have not been good.

• Poles has really attacked the better athletes high in the draft. Outside of Caleb Williams, six of his seven top 65 selections have been on guys with a RAS of 9.2 or higher. He has the highest average RAS selections in the top two rounds of any GM since 2019. RB Trestan Ebner is the only player that Poles has drafted with a RAS of less than 7.0.

• He has shown a good tendency to attack the premium positions with his early picks and then less so late. Nine of his 10 top three round picks have been on players at premium positions. Six of his eight picks from round 6-7 have been on non-premium position players.

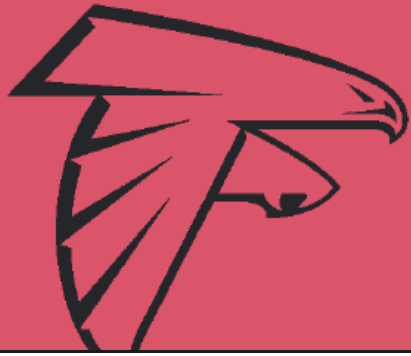

Fontenot is one of the GMs who just loves his athletes at flashy positions and is not afraid to grab them.

- Among the four non-Michael Penix selections inside the top 35 from Fontenot, all of them generated an elite RAS of 9.65 or higher. Bijan Robinson, Kyle Pitts and Drake London all play flashy skill positions, generated absurdly high RAS scores and entered the draft at a very young age (21.2 or less).
- Fontenot also drafted one of just 10 players with a perfect 10.0 RAS in the last five drafts, LB Troy Andersen.
- Fontenot loves his front four as he has selected six edge rushers and three DT in his four drafts. Unfortunately, only 2nd round pick Arnold Ebiketie, looks to be a useful NFL player among them.
